



International Actor's Fellowship 2009

How applicants apply:

The Fellowship is a four week intensive course set up to introduce experienced actors from around the world, preferably with experience in performing Shakespeare, to the unique Globe stage and the methods we've learnt here from playing this extraordinary space. Designed as professional development for mid-career actors, participants get the chance to work with our text, voice and movement experts and to investigate the Shakespearean stage and the challenges and discoveries it brings.

The course runs at Shakespeare's Globe, London from Monday 10 August with a final presentation on the Globe stage to an invited audience at 2.00pm on Monday 7 September 2009.

Over the past years, actors who have taken part in this programme have benefitted from it immensely and they continue to pass on their experiences of playing the original Shakespearean stage in their own countries.

The International Artistic Fellowship costs £4,250 per participant which covers accommodation and tuition fees. Travel and living costs are additional.

Process

To apply for the International Actor's Fellowship please send a letter of intent explaining why you were drawn to apply for this programme, what you hope to gain from it and how you will use the experiences gained from the scheme, along with your CV (two pages maximum) and a recent photograph

This must be accompanied by the application.

All applications to be submitted by Friday 8 May 2009.

Selection

The selection process will take place by the end of May.

Once the selection of the Artistic Fellows has been made a contract will be prepared setting out the programme in detail and the financial responsibilities of the Artistic Fellow.
